

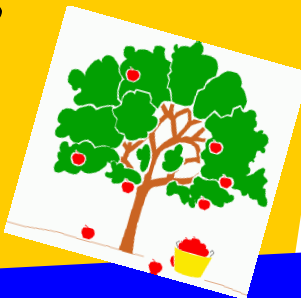

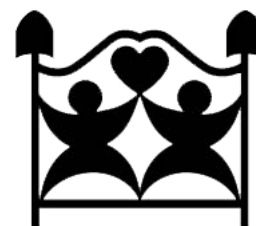
- 8:30—WELCA will be serving breakfast to get you going—great food priced right!
